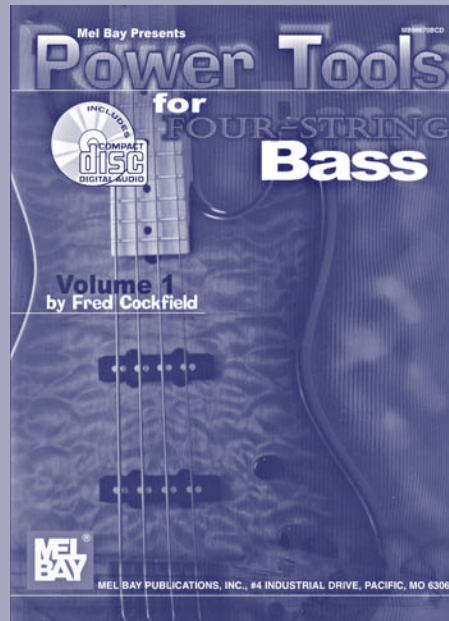
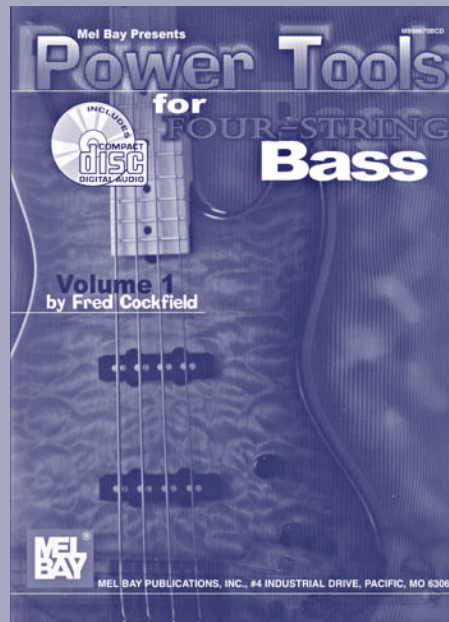




New books available include "Power Tools for 5 String Bass" and "Power Tools for 4 String Bass."

He continues to teach students at various locations around the Seattle area.
