 - b. Getting the wagon downtown for the 4th.
 - c. Take an inventory of the beer.
 - d. Get left over beer back.
 - e. Coordinate workers.
- g. Our August 28th meeting will begin an hour early due to the Packer vs. Cincinnati game. Orrin will have this game playing on a big screen after the meeting.
- h. August 4th is our White Cane Day. Orrin and Ron Pierdzioch will help Dan Salewske on this day.
- i. We had been asked to name a leader dog. Motion by Bob Houston, seconded by Dr. Dave Imm to name the dog Lucky.

 - \$7,500 was gross earnings.
 - Expenses totaled \$5,518.
 - \$1,982 is our net earnings (\$600 more than last year).
 - n. Lions Camp movie and discussion lead by Lion Jack Kasper.
 - \$550 per child for a week at Lions camp.
 - We had one camper from Tomahawk and it was back in 2001.
 - There are 4 programs:
 1. Blind and visually impaired
 2. Deaf and hearing impaired
 3. Diabetic camp
 4. Mild cognitively disabled.
 - The Health Lodge is having problems. It is not up to code, there is little to no privacy for the campers, and security is a major concern. The Lions need between \$550,000 and \$600,000 to build a new Health Lodge.
 - Half of the Sports Raffle proceeds go into the annual budget to run Lions Camp. The other half of the proceeds go to the local Lions club.
