Paperwork must be completed by March in order to receive donation. Paperwork will be given to Lion Secretary Fran Moss by Lion Wishneski.

Lion Erickson read request for funds from Vanessa Barr who will be touring in Europe with the Wisconsin Ambassadors of Music. Lion Wishneski to phone Ms Barr to tell her of the donation and request that she speak with the Club of her experience upon her return from the tour. Motion made by Lion Wickstrom to donate \$200; seconded by Lion Dettmering. Motion carried.

Committee Reports

Lion Salewske reported that he has Dr Maley on board to professionally evaluate and determine need for visually impaired needing assistance. Dr Maley has stated that she will help supplying glasses in the same way her predecessor (Dr Hagen) had. Lion

Awards Dinner and Valentine's Party, February 11, 2008: Mr Bill's has been selected as the location. Lion Dettmering volunteered to chair committee. His duties are to purchase Valentine's gifts and favors for spouses, find entertainment, and have a committee phone members and widows to determine how many will attend. Meal is \$10 per person (tip included).

Hardship Members: Per Board Of Directors meeting, Board Of Directors have approved hardship memberships on a case basis. Those who qualify would have their annual dues paid by the Club; hardship members would pay for meals unless s/he has worked an event. Lion Kolberg made motion; Lion Sawisky seconded. Motion carried. Lion Brehmer to contact current hardship member to inform of new guidelines for 2008-2009.

Lion Sawisky read request from Loaders to be a location for meetings; requested was deferred to Food Committee. Meeting locations are already determined through June, 2008. Lion Salewske stated that it would make his job as fund raiser a lot easier if the business was spread throughout the community. 2008 incoming officers will need to consider alternate locations.
