Dear Members of St. Joseph's Parish,

As I write, I am preparing for the meeting this evening with Catholic Extension of Chicago - the national parish support organization. They will consider financial support for the Catholic parishes in Elko county, and also Battle Mountain and Eureka. These are the parishes and missions, outside of the city of Elko, that presently receive subsidies from the Diocese of Reno, funded by the CSA. It would be a tremendous blessing if this was to happen. Also, they will visit and examine our new Our Lady of the Rubies Chapel in Spring Creek, and will decide if they will make a financial grant toward the cost of construction. Their team consists of Mike Carroll, Director of Development West Coast Region, Sam Abbasi, Director of Annual Giving, and photographer Rich Kolonick. My own feeling is that they would not go to the expense of making the trip out here unless they are fairly positive that support will be forthcoming!

Once again your kind hearted giving expressed itself in our Second Collection last weekend to support Catholic Relief Services Japan appeal. Of your generosity you gave \$4995.19, and this has been forwarded to CRS.

We are continuing to accept your pledges to the Catholic Services Appeal. If you have not received the pledge card you may pick one up at the parish office, or we can mail it to you. The CSA funds the programs of the Diocese of Reno, and subsidizes parishes and missions that are not self-supporting.

We are looking forward to hosting the NET team of which parish member Cristina Martinez is a part, who will spend Holy Week with us. They will lead us in an outdoor Stations of the Cross on Good Friday afternoon.

The renovation of the restrooms in Mater Dei Hall continues, and it is looking good.

When the weather improves we await Montrose Glass, who will install the protective windows for our stained glass windows in the church.

Please let me know if you notice a maintenance issue on our property, or if there is another project that might be looked into.
