Wrestling With the Word

Here is an excerpt from the accompanying description of the latest (May 5-8, 2011) Gallup poll on the Bible:

"Three in 10 Americans interpret the Bible literally, saying it is the actual word of God. That is similar to what Gallup has measured over the last two decades, but down from 1970s and 1980s. A 49% plurality of Americans say the Bible is the inspired word of God but that it should not be taken literally, consistently the most common view in Gallup's nearly 40-year history of this question. Another 17% consider the Bible an ancient book of stories recorded by man."

So is the Bible "Actual word of God?" Is it "Inspired word of God?" Is it a "Book of fables/legends?"

According to the poll, 21% (compared to 41% among

Protestants/Christians) of Catholics hold the view that the Bible is "actual word of God." 60% of Catholics (versus 60% of Protestants/Christians) consider the Bible as "Inspired word of God." 9% (compared to 10% of Protestants/Christians) think of the Bible as a "Book of fables/legends."

What does a good Catholic like you think? What does the Catholic church teach about the Bible?

have mercy on us;

you are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer.

For you alone are the Holy One,

you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen

New Text

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory.
