Dear Members of St. Joseph's Parish Community:

November is the "month of the dead" in our Catholic tradition. We begin the month celebrating All Saints Day and All Souls Day, and we continue to be mindful of our dearly departed during the rest of the month.

This might be a good time also to remind ourselves of the Catholic Church's unique teaching on Purgatory and prayer for the dead. We can read the official teaching in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (1030), defining purgatory as "a purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven," which is experienced by those "who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified."

The Book of Revelation (21:27) teaches that nothing unclean will enter the presence of God, so though we might die without mortal sin, there may still be impurities in us that would be "taken care of" in Purgatory.

We also believe in two judgments, the one that happens immediately after we die, and in the General Judgment, spoken of in the gospel of Matthew (25:31-32). "It is appointed for men to die once, and after that comes judgment" (Hebrews 9:27).

When we pray the Apostles' Creed, we state that we believe in the communion of saints. In that short statement we are speaking of that chain of prayer that connects us, the living, with those in Purgatory, and of course, with the saints in Heaven. In the Eucharistic Prayer of each Mass we offer prayers for the dead. It is also a common practice to have a particular Mass dedicated to the prayerful memory of our dead. Remember, all the dead are included in the prayers of the Mass, but we are allowed to remember our own particular deceased, perhaps a family member or friend who has passed away.

A reminder that our "countdown" to using the new Roman Missal continues, and we officially begin saying the new Mass prayers on November 26/27, the First Sunday of Advent. The new missalette will have the new responses of course, but you will be glad also to have the pew cards available. The handout in this bulletin is one more explanation of the new prayers. You might want to look it over as we prepare for the change. God bless, Father Dan
