Dear Members of St. Joseph's Parish Community:

At the beginning of the New Year we will be changing the way we handle weekly contributions for parish support. Rather than receiving your offering envelopes through the mail, we will instead give you a book of envelopes, which will contain offering envelopes for each Sunday and holyday, and other special collections, for the entire year of 2012. Your book of envelopes will have a designated number for each family. Your donations will be posted to that number, and at the end of the year you will receive a statement of your contributions for tax purposes.

There are several advantages to the change. First, it will be more cost effective. It is expensive to mail the envelopes each month. We are a fluid parish, in that we see families come and go all the time, for work reasons. Changes of address are an additional expense. Second, my hope is that more families will use collection envelopes, from which the majority of our income is received. Right now 329 families receive envelopes in the mail. We have about 1450 families registered in our parish, so the number of envelope users is rather small. For the most part, those who use collections envelopes or checks have already decided, in advance, how much of their income to tithe to their parish. If we could encourage more families to use envelopes, it would really help us to see our weekly giving as a sacrificial act of faith and commitment. The new envelope books will be distributed toward the end of the year, at all parish Masses, so that will give all of our families an opportunity to tithe in this way, rather than casual giving during Mass. These days, we are moving more and more away from using cash, and instead debit and credit cards are widely used. To this extent we also encourage online giving: if you go to our parish web page, <http://myplace.frontier.com/~stjoech>, you can make a secure donation to your parish.

Also, when new families come to register, we can give them a book of envelopes, rather than go through the process of putting them on a mailing list. We are indeed very blessed to have a very generous parish. In turn, your Parish Finance Council makes sure that your money is spent prudently. The diocese also monitors the budget of each parish, so that we can feel confident that our contributions are handled wisely. Our Finance Council meets on a regular basis, to monitor our budget, and to approve spending projects. The members - Tom Gust, Barry Lipparelli, Mark Paris, Jean Sloan, Annette Mills and Bob Smith - all bring their financial expertise to the table, and I am grateful for their commitment.
