Dear Members of St. Joseph's Parish Community:

You may recall the official visit we received, almost a year ago, from Catholic Extension. This is the national Catholic organization that funds projects in areas of the United States that are considered to be "mission territory." The diocese of Reno falls under that category. Their last project completed in our diocese was the part funding of the new church that has been constructed in Fernley - St. Robert's.

We presented to Catholic Extension a wish list for our parish, including our new chapel in Spring Creek, and an outline of what will be needed in the future to support the pastoral life of this parish. Recently, Mike Quilici, the director of development for our diocese of Reno, informed me that Catholic Extension will support our parish with a grant.

Their plan involves matching funds with our own fund-raising. If within the parish we are able to pledge in fund-raising \$150,000, they will add \$75,000, bringing it to a total of \$225,000. We have to formally organize the pledge campaign before the end of this current year, as the funding will be included in their 2011 budget.

We are extremely grateful to Catholic Extension for their generosity, given the many demands on their resources. In the past six years Catholic Extension has provided more than \$100 million to support Catholic communities across the United States.

How can you support our goal of raising \$150,000 in order to receive an additional \$75,000 from Catholic Extension? If, for example, you decide you can pledge \$100, Catholic Extension will add \$50 to your pledge.

One great advantage is that we do not have to have all the pledge money in our account before the end of the year. After you make your pledge, you may if you wish make payments over 10 months. For example, if you pledge \$100, you may make ten payments of \$10 over ten months. To make it easier to submit your pledge, your new Offering Envelope booklet will have a special envelope each month, titled "St. Joseph's Building & Development Fund." You may use this envelope to make your pledge payments. You may also make your payments online on the Parish website.

Part of the work of your Pastoral Council will be to identify priority projects for the parish in the future. I know that one priority that needs to be addressed is the restrooms in the church. As you well know, they are not adequate and hardly accessible to people with a disability.

We have designated the First Sunday of Advent, November 26/27, as Pledge Sunday. I would ask you to prayerfully consider supporting this fund-raising so that we are ready to continue to grow as a parish. Again,

we do need to reach the goal of \$150,000 in order to get the top up of \$75,000 from Catholic Extension. We have approximately 1,500 families registered in our St. Joseph's Parish. I am confident that we will reach our goal. God bless, Father Dan
