Dear Members of St. Joseph's Parish Community:

This coming weekend, though very busy, will I'm sure be memorable, and a blessing for all. We will host Bishop Calvo for three days as he officiates several functions. The highlight, I think, will be on Friday, October 14, when he will ordain as deacon our seminarian, Teo (Doroteo) Rojas. If you have never attended the ordination of a priest or deacon, I would encourage you to be part of this liturgy, which is as profound as it is moving. As in a priestly ordination, the deacon is ordained through the laying on of hands, after which he is invested (dressed) in the liturgical robes of a deacon: the stole and the dalmatic. Teo will be a transitional deacon, that is, later he will be ordained priest (probably early summer 2012).

As a deacon, Teo will be authorized to baptize, to officiate at marriages, and to proclaim the gospel and preach the homily at Mass. A deacon may not celebrate Mass himself, hear confessions, or administer the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

For a couple of months, until Teo returns to the seminary after the Christmas break, we will have three deacons ministering in our parish! Believe me, there is more than enough work to keep them all busy! As an aside, I think you will agree with me when I say that Deacon Franklin Martinez will be most competent in his ministry. I received so many positive comments following his recent first time preaching at Sunday Mass.

The following day, Saturday, Bishop Calvo will chair the annual general meeting of the Eastern Nevada Parish Corporation - this is the collective title for our area parishes and missions, since we were legally incorporated last year. The annual general meeting is a requirement of incorporation.

On Sunday, October 16, Bishop Calvo will again preside at two important liturgies. At the Spanish Mass Bishop Calvo will confirm a group of Spanish-speaking adults, who have been faithfully preparing for this sacrament for many months. Later, at 4:00 PM, the bishop will bless our new chapel in Spring Creek. This is not a consecration as such, as this new chapel is not a parish church, but an annex to St. Joseph's Church. All are invited, of course, but seating is limited in the chapel. The Knights of Columbus will host a barbecue following the Mass.

We really are truly blessed as a parish, and we give thanks to our God for His watchful care over this Nevada flock!
