The museum has an extensive collection of Native American artifacts from tribes all across the United States, Canada, and Alaska. Some of the native costumes were very ornate

with all their beadwork and decorations. Also of interest was a re-created trading post stocked with authentic trade goods.

After touring the museum, we went into the ceremonial long house where we were greeted by a crackling fire. The house seemed dark at first but as our eyes grew accustomed to the light we saw we were in a large room with a dirt floor and benches surrounding the fire. The room became a little smoky and our eyes watered before the program was over as the smoke lazily wandered up to the smoke hole at the top of the house.



Chief Lelooska welcomed us to his lodge and entertained us with many Native American stories and legends.

Chief Lelooska came out in his ceremonial robe and welcomed us to his lodge. Then, he introduced his daughter who proceeded to dance many of the native dances while Chief Lelooska explained the meaning behind each mask and dance. Overall. it was very informative and enjoyed by all.
