The meeting will begin at 7:30 p.m. at the Mound Depot community building at 5801 Bartlett Blvd. in Mound, in the Mound Bay Park.

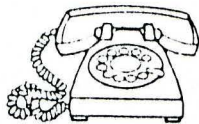
Refreshments will be served at the close of the meeting, and all are invited to attend.
