Also, bring your family and friends and your favorite dish (plus plates and silverware).

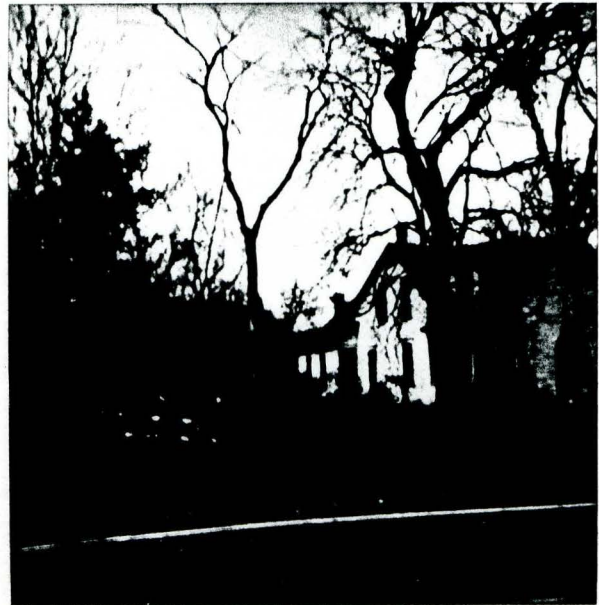
If you want to find out what to bring and what dish would be most needed, you can call the secretary at 472-1885.
