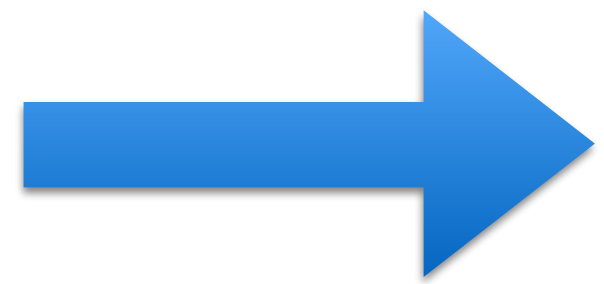

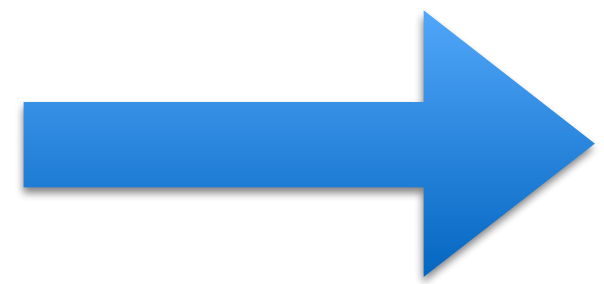

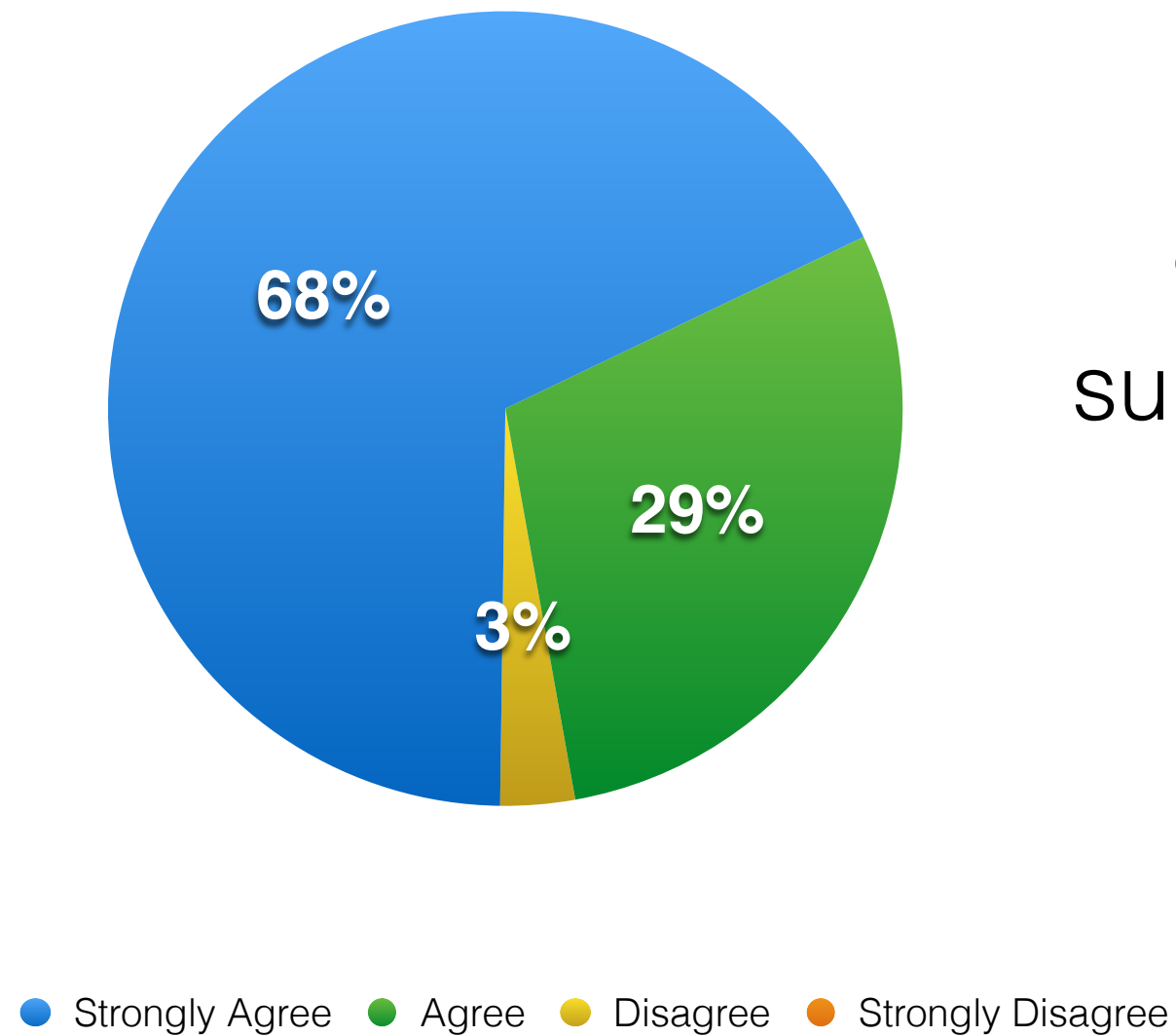

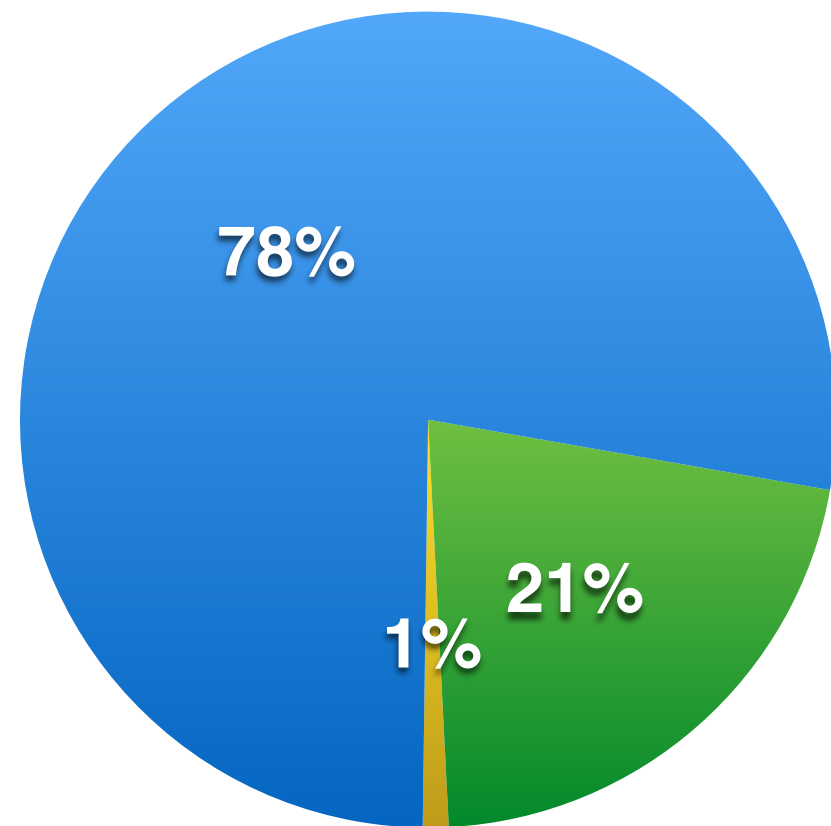
High Expectations

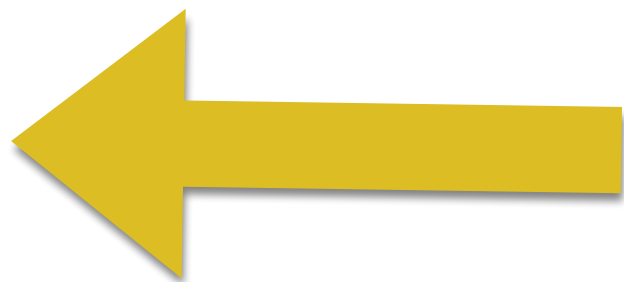

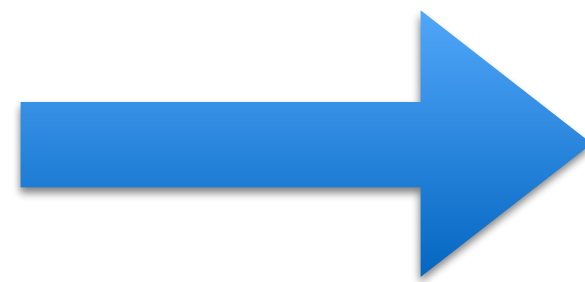
Planning that Engages

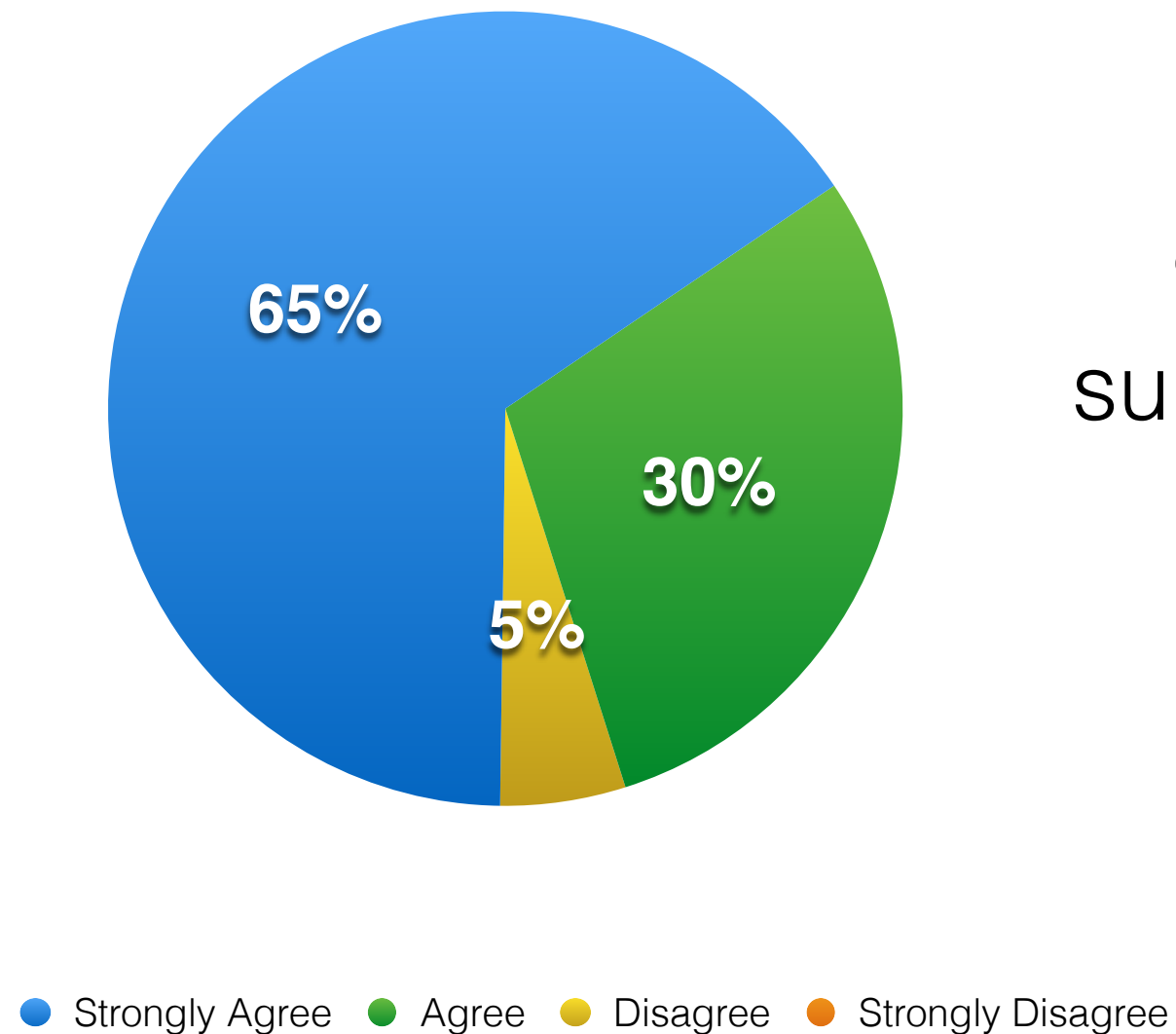

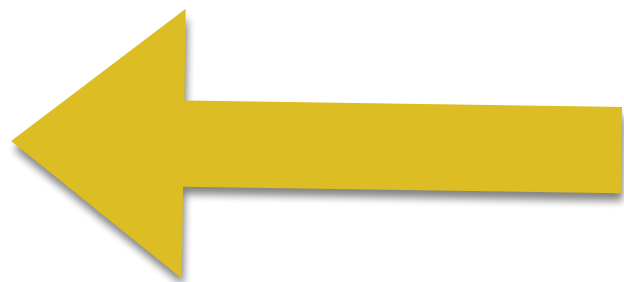

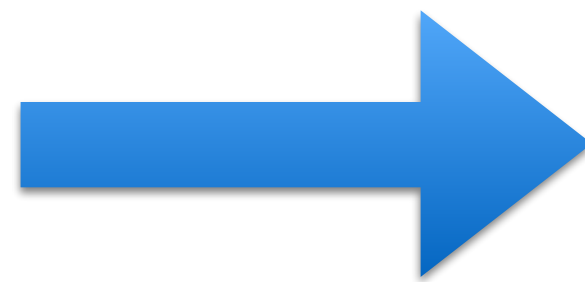
Monitoring Student Progress

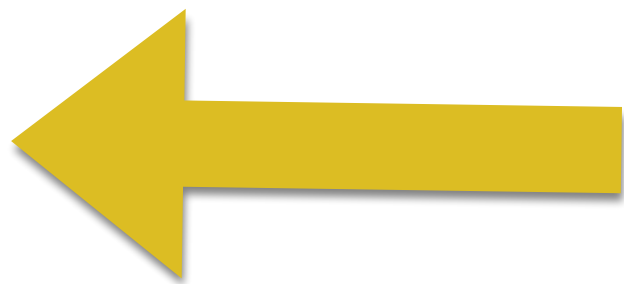

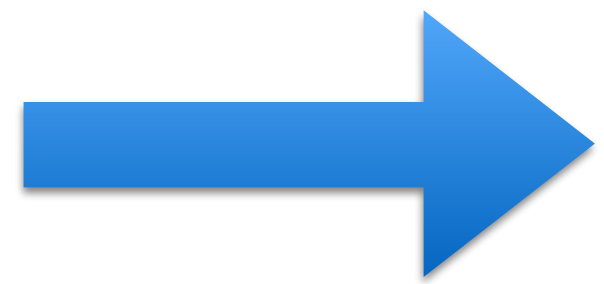

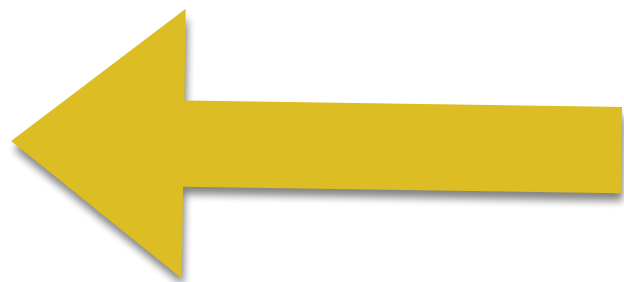

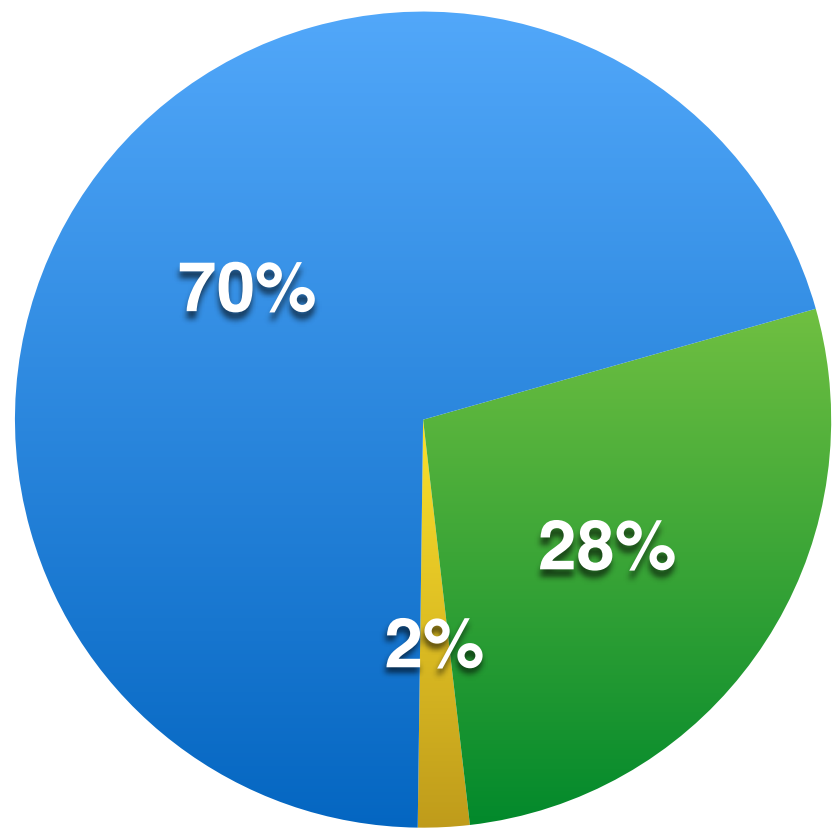

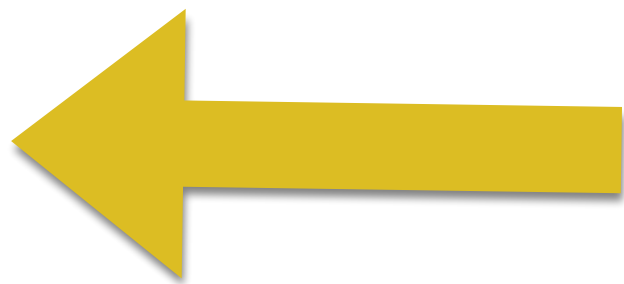

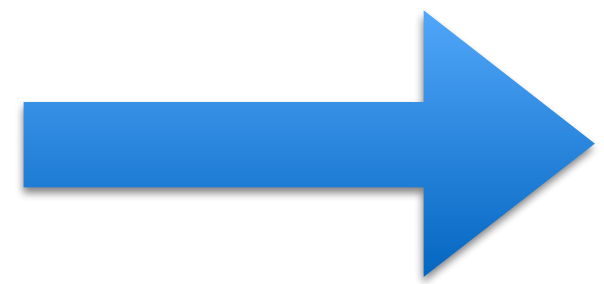

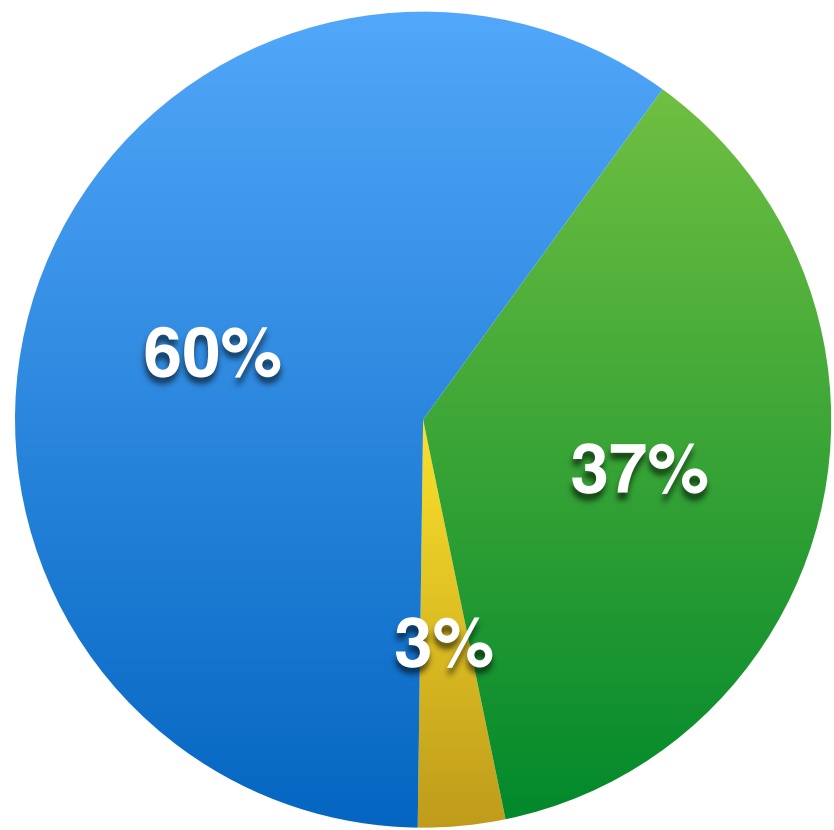

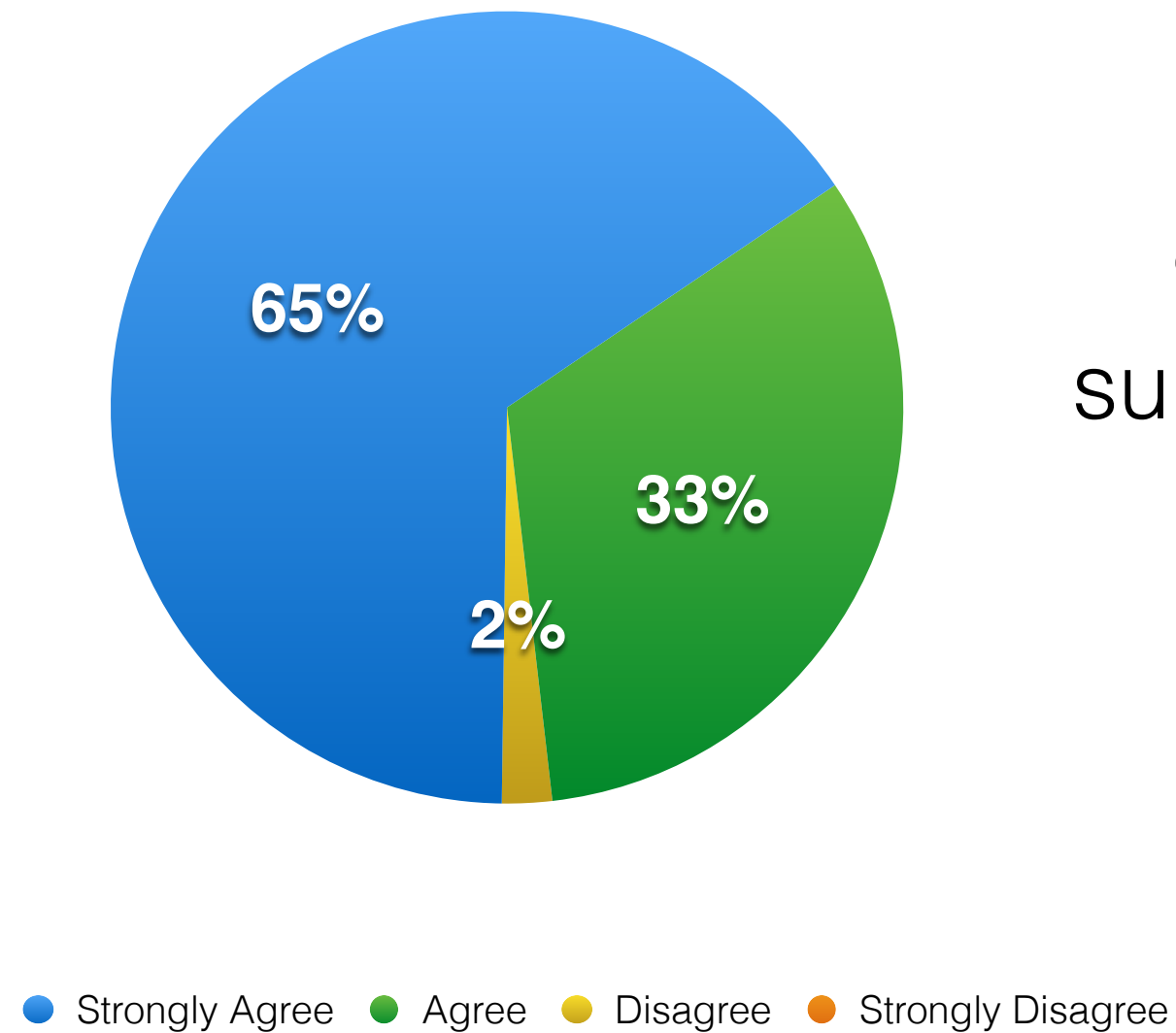

On the Tripod Survey, statements that dealt with clarity in general ranged from 70-80%

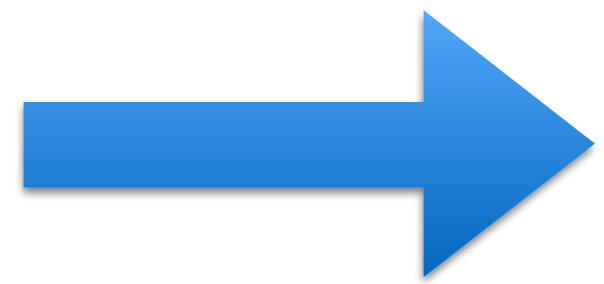

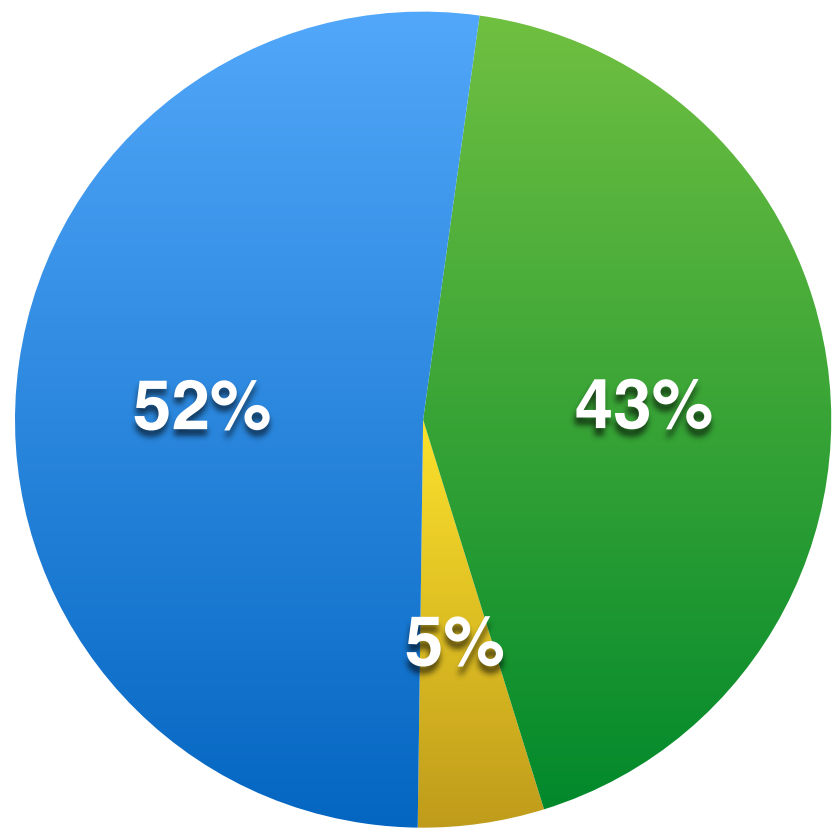

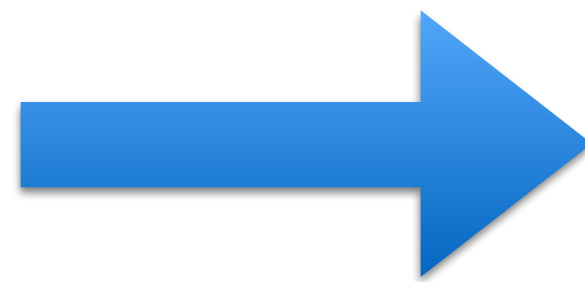

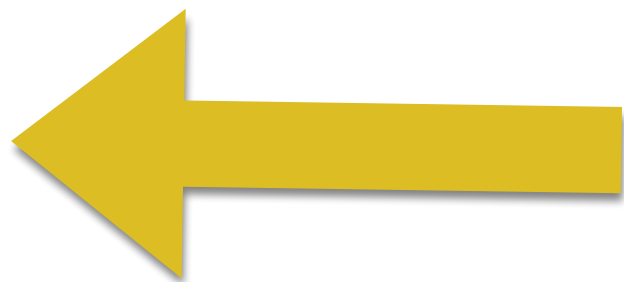

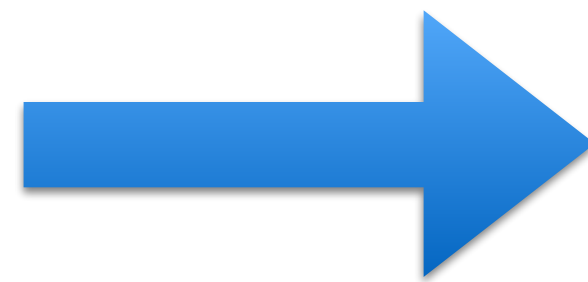

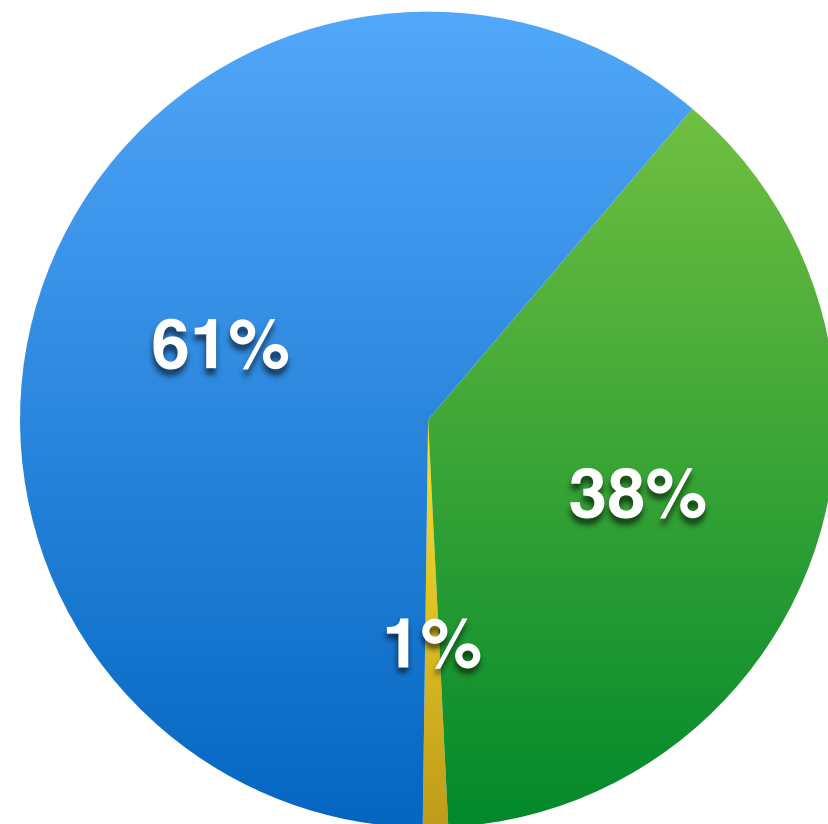

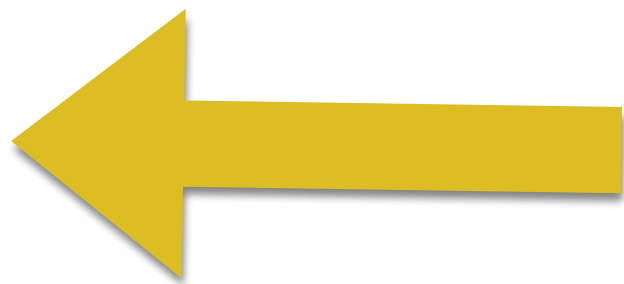

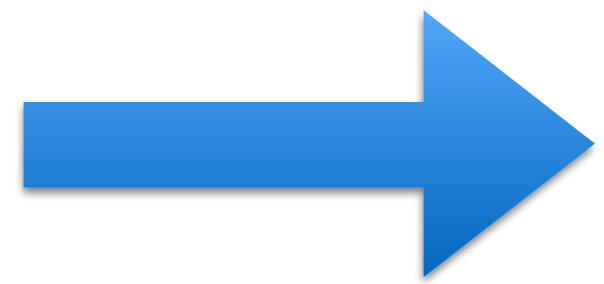

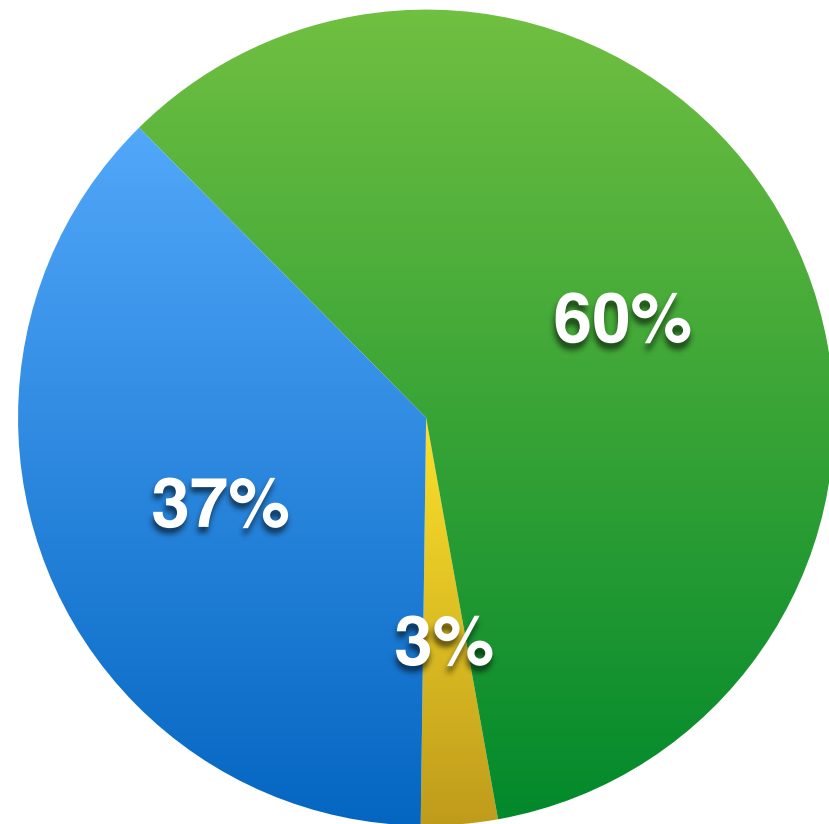
