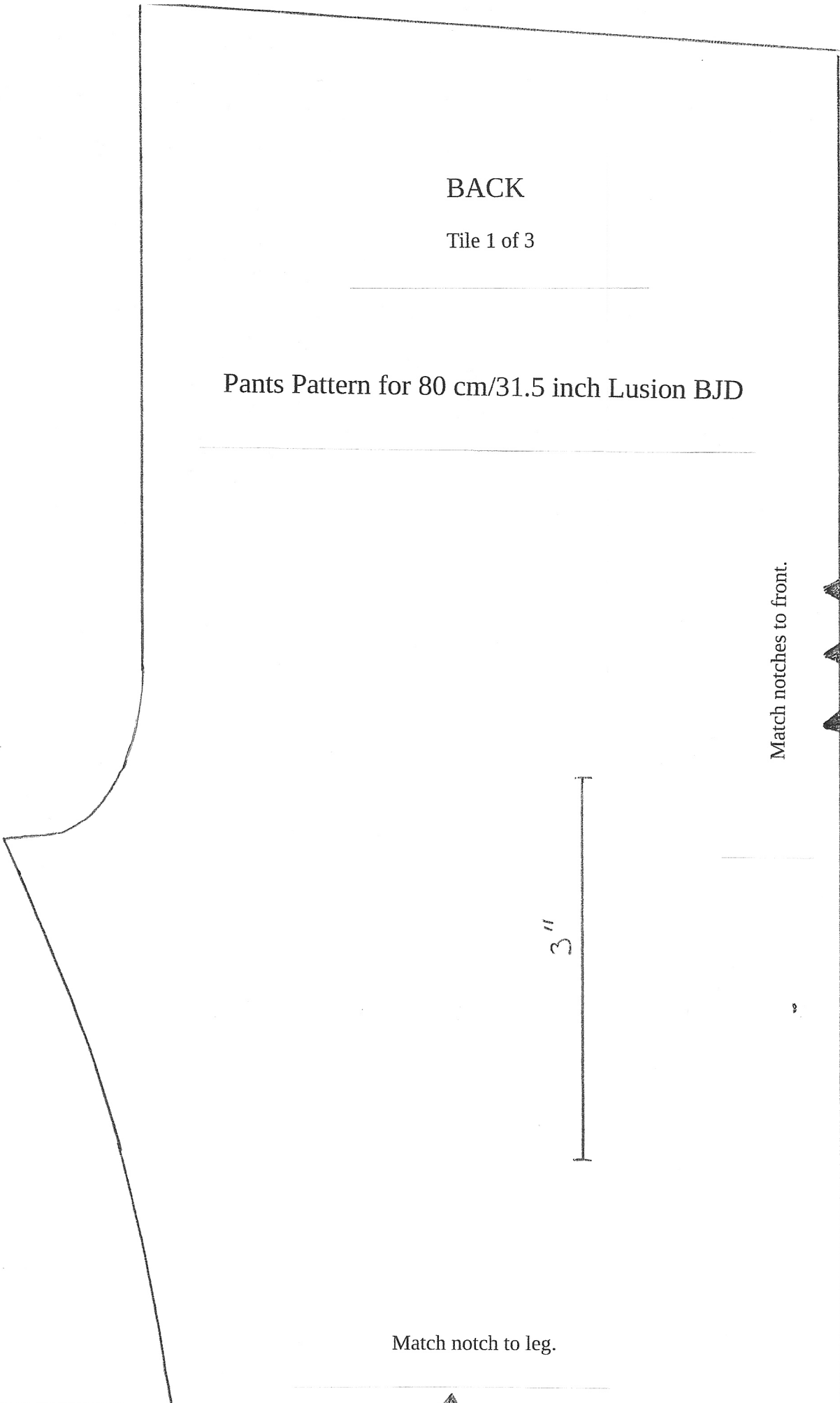
Tile 1 of 3

Pants for 80 cm/31.5 inch Lusion BJD from Dollmore

You will need: fabric, thread and 11 inches ¼ inch wide elastic

Seams are ¼ inch except for waist casing which is ½ inch fold-down and 5/8 inch casing.

Assemble 4 tiles of pants pattern: back, front, leg, and 1"x 10" strip if making full length pants.

Cut 2 fabric pieces.

Sew front and back crotch seams, backstitching at beginning and end of each seam.

Press to set seams. Press seams open.

Trim curved areas of crotch seams to about 1/8 inch wide and clip curved seams.

Finish seams, if desired.

Meeting crotch seams, sew inseam from hem to hem. Pin before sewing, if needed.

Press to set seam. Press seam open.

Trim inseam in crotch area to about 1/8 inch wide and clip.

Finish seam, if desired.

Fold down ½ inch at waist, then 5/8 inch for casing. Edge stitch bottom edge of casing, leaving at least 1.5 inches opening at center back for inserting elastic.

Cut an 11 inch length of elastic and insert into casing. Pin elastic ends together and put pants on BJD.

Adjust elastic to fit BJD's waist. (Variations in fabric weight and elastic will affect fit.) Sew elastic ends together with zigzag stitch. Close casing opening with straight stitch.

Place pants on BJD and determine desired pant length, adding 1 inch for hem. Fold up hems ¼ inch and press. Fold up a scant ¾ inch. Pin, if needed. Sew pant hems.

Press pants.

Have fun!

Notes: In this pattern, the front is ¾ inch lower than the back. (That's where the waist seemed to naturally settle on my Lusion BJD.) If desired, you can cut the fabric straight across and tighten elastic to keep the waist level.

These pants can be shortened to any length for different looks.
