

Cloth Cap for 80 cm/31.5 inch Lusion BJD

Crown: cut 2

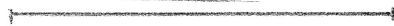
2"



Place on fold.

Side/Tie End: cut 2 on fold

2"



Attach tie end here.

Attach to side here.

Tie End

Cloth Cap for 80 cm/31.5 inch Lusion from Dollmore by Answer42

Materials: fabric, thread

Note: $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowances are included for all seams.

Print out pattern and attach tie end pattern piece to the side pattern piece.

Cut out 2 sides on the fold of fabric. Cut out 2 crowns.

Place the 2 crowns right sides together and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam along straight edge. Press.

Turn seam to the inside and topstitch seam. Press.

Pin topstitched crown piece between the 2 side pieces, matching center fronts and ties. (Make a sandwich of a side, sewn-together crowns and a side.) Pin carefully around curve.

Starting near but not on the topstitched crown seam, sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam around the tie, around the crown and around the second tie, stopping near but not on the topstitched crown seam.

Clip tie corners. Trim and notch curve of crown. Use pinking shears, if available. Press and turn ties and cap right-side out.

Press up $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance on bottom edge of both side pieces and edge stitch.

Topstitch ties and seams, if desired.

Have fun!

Note: You can use just one crown piece and one side piece, if desired. Using 2 of each piece encloses all raw edges and gives a fuller look to the cap.

This cap can achieve different looks depending on fabric and placement on Lusion's head.
