

April 1 - Palm Sunday - Liturgy of the Palms at 8:00 a.m. and 10 a.m.

Wednesday in Holy Week - Healing mass at 6:30 p.m.

Maundy Thursday - 7:00 p.m. Mass followed by all night prayer vigil

Good Friday - 12:15 liturgy with holy communion (40 minutes)

7:00 p.m. liturgy with holy communion and choir

Holy Saturday - 9:00 a.m. liturgy

April 8 - Easter Sunday - Easter liturgy at 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.

Pastor's Pen

It happened so fast. It seems like we were just celebrating Christmas, and we look up and its Holy Week and Easter! The days and weeks are speeding along, and like it or not Easter is here. Much like any other holiday season or date on the calendar, it comes along at a certain time whether or not we have prepared for it or are ready to celebrate it. When it's Christmas season, we hope that we don't find ourselves at 5:00 p.m. Christmas Eve with all our shopping to do. At Easter, we hope that we do not find ourselves at 5:00 p.m. on Easter eve with a spirituality that has not been examined or prepared for Easter. We do this preparation throughout the Season of Lent, and especially through Holy Week. We begin on Palm Sunday with Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. We walk with him through the Last Supper (Maundy Thursday) and watch and pray with him in the garden of Gethsemane (the all night vigil). We stand with him as he is examined by Pontius Pilate and wrongfully accused, beaten and crucified (Good Friday). We Lucio E. M. mourn with others who loved him as we stand at the tomb and ponder the meaning of the events of the cross (Holy Saturday). We rejoice at his conquering of death

and resurrection from the dead (Eas-

ter Sunday). The events happen so fast that we can miss them if we are not careful. But these events are too important to miss. They are critical in our salvation story, and they are too important to just let them pass by. I invite you to enrich your celebration of Easter by participating in the Holy Week liturgies. By going from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday and not participating in Holy Week, you rob yourself of the rich spiritual experiences that Holy Week offers. There can be no Easter without the agony in the garden, the Last Supper, and the painful events of Good Friday. It happens quickly - the Passion of our Lord is an intense few days that have so much meaning. They are a few days that are easy to miss - days in which it is easy to be busy or occupied with other things. Don't let them sneak up on you or get away from you. Make Holy Week a priority so that Easter Sunday can be an even better spiritual gift. Lent means "Spring" - a time of renewal and refreshment, a time of new life. Easter celebrates that new life given to those who believe in Christ, and who truly appreciate and embrace the great sacrifice


