

# Wallowa County Fly-In Pilot Information Sheet

- Welcome to Wallowa County !
- **Airspace Closure / Reopening** will coincide with the airshow rehearsal on Friday (1100L – 1300L) and the airshow on Saturday (1015L – 1130L) as described in NOTAMS. Please check NOTAMS !
- **No Spinning Props on the ramp inside of fenced spectator area on Saturday morning.**
- **All pilots and passengers need to be in the spectator area and off of the taxiway, parking and camping areas during the airshow rehearsal on Friday 1045 – 1300 and airshow on Saturday from 1000 to 1130.**
- **First Aid Station** will be located at the 2<sup>nd</sup> big hangar from the north end.
- **COVID-19 Considerations** – Oregon is open as of 6/30/21 without a masking policy or capacity limitation outdoors. For the comfort of all visitors, please maintain social distancing as much as practical.
- **Camping** is permitted on the grass area west of the taxiway. Camp near your aircraft or under a wing and be sure all of your gear is tied down and secure. Vacate during waiver period described above.
- **Fuel will not be available during the airshow rehearsal on Friday 1045 – 1300 and airshow on Saturday from 1000 to 1130.**
- **Tiedowns** are not available in the grass parking areas.
- **Pedestrian Traffic** – Please walk on the east side of taxiway and cross where directed near the fuel pad and then to the check-in tent.
- **Banquet and Breakfast Tickets** - can be purchased at the check-in tent.
- **Pets** are allowed but they must be kept on a leash.
- **Bicycles** cannot be ridden on the field or ramp. Please walk your bikes to the gate.

- **Aircraft Parking** is done at the discretion of the Ramp Boss and crew. Be sure to let them know your intentions about staying for the show, for breakfast only or camping.
- **Smoking** is not allowed anywhere on the field.
- **Ramp Area Etiquette** – the ramp will have numerous display aircraft. Please do not touch aircraft and keep an eye on the kids. Please stay clear of aircraft that are being moved.
- **Transportation to Town – Shuttle, Courtesy Cars are available.**
- **Hospitality – Please check out the hospitality hangar for visiting pilots and passengers. Please consider donations to the NEOAF.**
- **Noise Abatement – Be courteous. Please do not loiter over town, Wallowa Lake or south of the field.**
